As we conclude this series of lessons tonight on “Winning the war of the Mind”, There is one final consideration and revelation that we must have if we are to be victorious in the mental crisis that we encounter as we attempt to live like Christ.

If we are going to defeat:

Lies that come in our head

Deceptions that the devil bring

Imaginations drawn on the canvass of our cognition

WE HAVE TO HAVE THE MIND OF CHRIST

Having the Mind of Christ: Means having His attitude, His Values and His Principles in critical moments!

We have to have the mind of Christ, when we're in a crisis of mind, as He was throughout his life. The times of testing and tempting that Christ encountered, were moments of Crisis of mind!

Closing lesson: “Winning the Crisis of the Mind, with the Mind of Christ”

Philippians 2:5. “Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus; who being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of man: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross”

1 Corinthians 2:14-16. “But the natural man receiveth not the things of God; for they are foolishness unto him; neither can he know them because they are spiritual discerned. But he that is spiritual judgeth all things, yet he himself is judged of no man. For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ”

In this Christian life, We're gonna be tested and tempted like Christ. Just like Him, we all have our crosses that we have to bear! (If we're gonna have Christ's Victory, we have to have His mentality).

Having the mind of Christ means “we look at life from our Savior's point of view”

The outlook of Christ's Mind, yielded His Outcome!!!

Let's define the mind of Christ, so that we can have His mind in our crisis!!

The three defining mind sets that we are going to define we're consistently seen in the crisis and comforts of Christ's life!

A. A Mind to Bring God Glory

When we think to bring God glory, in all that we do and go through, It has a tendency to tame our minds in the crisis of life.

In the High Priestly prayer of John 17. Jesus repeatedly desired to glorify the Father!
He wanted His Father to shine more than Him!

B. A Mind of Humility

Humility is to lower in condition, importance or dignity. Abase

Although He was God's son, He was not full of pride and arrogance

(Oftentimes it's our high estimation of ourselves that causes us to respond the way we do. It also causes us to defend ourselves).

C. A Mind of God Dependency

Dependency on God, is knowing that God is the only way we can make it. It's looking to God, praying to God. Seeking God. Etc.

There are several Luke 5:16 encounters throughout Jesus' life
He often withdrew to lonely places and prayed.

In Closing, When the Apostle Paul was speaking to the Corinthian Christians, He said "We have the mind of Christ"

Which means:

We have the Capacity of Christ in us, through the Holy Spirit

We Have the Identity of Christ

We Have the Ability of Christ
