Understanding Spiritual Gifts (Part 1)

The subject of spiritual gifts was very important in the life of the E_____ church.

The modern church is not as effective as it could and should be because most Christians don't know their spiritual gift/s.

Every child of God has a gift or gifts. Our gifts are assigned to us when we are B_____ by the Holy Spirit into the family of God. (Eph. 4:7)

What Is A Gift?

There are two Greek words used in the N.T. for spiritual gifts. The first word is *pneumatikon*, which means S_____ (1 Cor. 12:1).

Second, the normal word for spiritual gifts is *charisma* (plur., *charismata*). The term has three uses in the N.T.:

1. It means God's gift of S_____ (Rom. 6:23)
2. It refers to B_____, encouragement (Rom. 1:11)
3. It relates to a special ability to minister with E_____ and P_____ that the Holy Spirit endows on the believer. (Rom. 12:6)

Definition: A spiritual gift is a divine, supernatural A_____ given by God to E_____ a Christian to serve and to minister.

The Difference Between Gifts and Talents

Talents—are natural-born abilities

Gifts—are abilities that one receives from God (1 Pet. 4:11)

- * Talents can be, and often are, avenues through which God uses individuals in His service.
- * Sometimes a person's talent can be avenues through which the Holy Spirit may choose to give them a spiritual gift.
